## Dale NasoGastric Tube Holder <br> Alternate Application Instructions

## Application Instructions

1. After the NG tube is in place, please make certain that the skin on the nose and the NG tube is both clean and dry. We recommend cleaning it per hospital protocol.
2. Peel back NG tube holder completely from liner starting at the top of the nose pad. Position and apply nosepad centered on the nose at a slight angle toward the nare that the NG tube has been inserted into. (see fig. 1)
3. Choose one of the two tabs closest to the nose and begin to wrap the tube in a spiraling fashion around it so most of the NG tube is centered on the selected nare. (see fig. 2)
4. Wrap the second remaining tab using the same spiral technique. (see fig. 2) The NG tube needs to hang freely below the nare, not snug up against it.
5. Change the tube holder after 3 days, or sooner if necessary.


## Removal Instructions

1. To remove the NG tube holder from the patient, simply pull back on the non-adherent tips on the end of each tab to unwrap them from the tube.
2. Continue to gently pull the tube holder in an upward fashion to remove from the patient's nose.
